On a 3x 5 index card, summarize what happened in each chapter on one side. On the other, analyze the importance of what happened and the reasons it happened.

Draw a line down the middle of the page. On one side write down an important quote from each chapter and on the other side comment on and analyze the quotes.

WRITE A biography of the character who most interests you.

Use the story that takes place in the novel as the basis for a court trial.

Write the script of the court case.
Include characters from the book as witnesses, judge, jury, attorneys, etc.

After you finish the book, write an epilogue. Explain, using whatever tense and tone the author does, what happened to the character(s) next.

Create a storyboard for each chapter of the book.

Acting as a reporter, write a script where you ask a character from the book questions to facilitate his/her perspective of what occurred in the story.

Pick the most important word, line, image, object, or event in the chapter and explain why you chose it. Be sure to support all analysis with examples from the text.

Write about how it would change the story if a certain character had made a different decision earlier in the story.
